Mission

Dunwoody United Methodist Church Preschool provides a developmentally appropriate education in a loving, Christian environment where children are nurtured and encouraged to develop cognitively, socially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually to their full potential.

Accreditation & Curriculum

Dunwoody UMC Preschool is fully accredited by Cognia. The preschool is also a member of the Georgia Preschool Association and the United Methodist Preschool Association of the North Georgia Conference.

Our program meets the Georgia Early Learning and Development Standards (GELDS) and the Georgia Kindergarten Standards of Excellence while maintaining a balance of active, child-initiated learning and teacher-directed instruction.

Staff

Our teachers are nurturing, skilled and experienced early childhood educators. High standards are maintained by participating in continuing education opportunities throughout the year. Teachers at DUMCP are committed to loving each child and encouraging their individual growth.

Parent Council

Parents are encouraged to get involved at the preschool. The Parent Council provides the framework for these opportunities. From party volunteers, room parents, helping on a committee, or chairing fundraisers such as the Fall Festival and Preschool Prom, there's a place for you to lend your time and talents, and moreover, to build community!

Security

Safety is a priority. Strict arrival and departure policies, a monitored security door access system, and police officer on site during regular school hours help keep the preschool secure.







Kindergarten Program

For the past decade, the curricula and teaching methods in the DUMCP Kindergarten program lay the foundation for success in local public and private schools. We meet the Georgia Standards of Excellence, and our classroom allows time for physical movement, active communication, individual and group problem solving, as well as small and large group instruction.

Specials: Music, Kindergym, and STEM

Music - An experienced music teacher provides a program designed specifically for each age group. Children enjoy music and movement. Performances are held for parents of Threes through Kindergarten classes at Christmas and in the spring.

Kindergym - Designed to promote the growth and development of every child's gross motor and locomotor skills. Students play age appropriate games, develop ball skills, run/climb/jump through obstacle courses, and stretch while having fun.

STEM (3s-K) - Students explore science, technology, engineering and math while developing problem solving, interpersonal, and communication skills.

Extended Day

We offer a lunch hour with supervised play, two additional blocks of time for play, and an array of optional Enrichment Classes such as cooking, art, ballet, tennis, STEM, Spanish, and phonics. There are three EXD sessions per school year, so you can set your child's schedule by session for a consistent weekly plan. Extended Day is divided in three time-blocks:

12:00 - 1:00, Lunch and supervised play: Threes & Fours - Mon-Fri; Twos, Tue-Thu 1:00 - 1:45, Supervised play or Enrichment Class: Threes, Fours, Kindergarten; Mon-Fri 1:45 - 2:30, Supervised play or Enrichment Class: Threes, Fours, Kindergarten; Mon-Thu

Dunwoody UMC Preschool is available for Toddlers (age one by 9/1/25) through Kindergarten (age five by 9/1/25). Each class is designed to meet the developmental needs of your child. Children flourish in a loving, Christian environment.

Registration for 2025-2026 occurs in January 2025.
